Brunei's Business Licensing System (BLS) is a flagship e-Government project that is jointly spearheaded by the **Ministry of Industry and Primary Resources (MIPR)** and the **Ministry of Home Affairs (MoHA)**.

Working closely with 13 government agencies, BLS aims to improve the country's global ranking in the World Bank's Ease of Doing Business report by cutting down the processes of applying for a new business by at least half (50 percent) once the system goes online.

Businessmen simply fill one integrated form and make one consolidated payment when applying for multiple licenses, without the need to visit the respective agencies.
