Accessibility, Productivity, Transparency, Clarity

- ICMS is an enabler of immediate, adequate and secure access to documents in Court cases.
- ICMS increases productivity, transparency and clarity in court procedures.
- ICMS transforms existing paper-based documents to electronic counterparts.

Transform, Standardize, Secure

- ICMS is envisioned to transform the criminal justice system of Singapore from one that is heavily paper-based to one that is fundamentally paperless.
- ICMS validates documents received and raises the standard of document submissions by more than 30 prosecuting, investigation and warrant enforcement agencies.
- ICMS integrates with existing case management systems.
- ICMS is designed to ensure non-repudiation and proper access to documents as they flow through the system.

- ICMS integrates with many existing purpose-built internal systems in the State Courts.
- ICMS paves way for a slew of automation options that would otherwise have been cumbersome and costly to implement with disparate systems.
- ICMS accelerates many court procedures and improve service standards across the departments in the State Courts.

Case Filing Management

- File case and court documents with the State Courts of Singapore electronically.
- Allows users to request for and extract official records from the Courts electronically.

Case Management

- Offers complete end-to-end management of a case life cycle from initiation and tracking to post-judgment activities.
- Workflows are defined and the case is automatically routed to the respective court and officer as required by the judicial workflow.

Document Management

- Electronic Service of Documents integrating with the Judiciary's workflow and external systems used by Agencies and Lawyers, enabling authorized Court documents to be accessed with ease.
- Serves and share documents with other agencies / lawyers electronically.
